## BEYOND THE GREEN AWARD

Each year the YMCA of the Capital Area presents the Beyond the Green Award to a member of the community who exemplifies the Y's mission of promoting Youth Development, Social Responsibility, and Healthy Living. This year's recipient is John M. Engquist.

John Engquist serves as Chief Executive Officer and Director of H&E Equipment Services, an integrated equipment services company founded by his father in 1961. Under Engquist's leadership, H&E is now a publicly traded company with over \$1 billion in annual revenues, nearly 90 locations nationwide and more than 2,000 employees. The H&E CEO is also one of the area's largest real estate developers with more than 3,000 home sites in three states.

Mr. Engquist serves as a director on the boards of a number of private companies. He also serves on the Leadership Council of St. Jude Children's Research Hospital in Memphis, Tennessee and serves as a board member of Dream Day Foundation, a non-profit organization founded in 1994 to support St. Jude and its patients. Additionally, Mr. Engquist serves on the Board of Directors of Our Lady of the Lake Regional Medical Center, based in Baton Rouge, Louisiana. The Engquists' recent donation to Our Lady of the Lake Children's Hospital will serve the hematology and oncology floor of the hospital to care for children with cancer and blood diseases. The Engquists' also donated land and made a significant capital gift to build the Americana YMCA in Zachary.

Mr. Engquist has been married to his wife, Marty, for 44 years. They have two sons, Ryan and John, and six grandchildren.
